Fees

Beginners Course

Basis Safety Measures

Always wear safety glasses when cutting and grinding.

No smoking or eating while grinding or soldering.

Wear flat, closed shoes and old clothes or an apron.

Patina contains nitric and selenium acids, wear gloves and avoid splashing.

Get into the habit of wearing a mask when soldering as solder and flux fumes are poisonous.

Always wash your hands after handling lead or solder and again before going home.

Always wash your hands after working with flux as the main chemical ingredient is hydrochloric acid.

Other Requirements

Small scissors, Superwipes or an absorbent cloth, Old towel

Prestik

Good quality insulation tape. Masking tape will not work

Small jars with lids for decanting flux, cutting oil, patina etc.
